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Good afternoon Steven, Andrew

Council have been requested to finalise their thoughts on SS going forward. Please see items below with which to allocate your officers please.

1) Communication - Improved communication channels between CPC and SS Officers. Please ask your officers to text our Police reps Roger Pearman 07809 483 232 and Paul Denton 07714 465 376 when they are starting and finishing a SS shift. They don't necessarily have to give details of the shift as this will be matched up with the SS Report.

To know that when the Safe Scheme Manager PC Firth is on days off or cannot answer his phone, that someone else will be accessible to speak to should the need arise.

That attendance at council meetings would be appreciated to discuss the SS report and ask any questions. Any questions from the report can be sent to Andy and Steven for an answer which can then be distributed to the councillors

Suggested between both CPC and Police that when PC Firth is on days off, communication can be fed through to Inspector Andrew Dickinson who is office-based Monday to Friday 8am -4pm.

That any questions arising from the SS report, and no representative is in attendance these can be taken down by the Clerk and forwarded onto both PC Firth and Inspector Andrew Dickinson for a response.

2) Parking - Obstructive and illegal parking in the parish, that falls under the Police's jurisdiction.

Suggested that Traffic Officer PC Nick Foster can be introduced to Crigglestone SS and can attend to carry out visits to known hot spots.

3) HGV's using restricted routes - Suggested that Traffic Officer PC Nick Foster can be introduced to Crigglestone SS and can attend to carry out visits to known hot spots.

4) Speeding vehicles - Suggested that Traffic Officer PC Nick Foster can be introduced to Crigglestone SS and can attend to carry out visits to known hot spots and carry out Smiley SID deployment to known hot spots e.g. Durkar Lane from the top of Stanbridge down to the roundabout on DD Road, High Street to Cliff Road to start with and give each area a months worth of attention.

5) Visibility and engagement of SS officers in the community – Please focus around Singe and Booze with high visibility whilst the issues with the ASB of the 'neighbour' there are better resolved (he lives on the end of the row between the shop and Grant and causes issues for the whole estate as you are well aware)

Suggested NPT shift finishing times are 4pm and 12 midnight. As long as there as officers who have signed up for it, a presence can be allocated for teatime/early evening in the areas that the council dictates.

6) Anti-Social Behaviour – Amounts to vandalism to memorial benches, drug taking and selling, fly tipping all taking place in Betty Eastwood Park

Please let me know if you have any difficulties with the above for whatever reason.

Our Police liaison representatives Cllr Roger Pearman and Cllr Paul Denton have been delegated to come along to the PACT meetings so they can see and hear what the public are reporting to you. Cllr Jane Ellis will attend in her resident capacity.
