Crime:

There has been an increase in priority crime this month from last month. There has been a suspect arrested for several theft of motor vehicle within the Crigglestone area along with other areas. This investigation is currently ongoing and awaiting crown prosecution service charging advice.

Rural NPT are currently running an operation within the ward cluster including the Crigglestone area targeting nominals linked to burglaries, this includes plain cloth operations with marked vehicles utilised for pursuits. Last week, as part of this operation, officers located a stolen vehicle on cloned registration plates being stopped and seized, which has been linked to thefts within the Crigglestone area, investigations are currently ongoing.

Patrols:

PC Foster reports,

I have paid attention to Durkar Lane, Denby Dale Road and Denby Dale Road East. Patrol was carried out in a marked RPU vehicle.

I paid attention around the One Stop Shop on Denby Dale Road East as requested by yourself. Vehicle and pedestrian movement was normal with no offences, just day to day business at the shop.

I have also paid attention to the 17t weight limit on Durkar Lane. No vehicles breached the restriction today whilst I was present.

2 x TOR – Non conforming VRM

1 x TOR – Drive otherwise than in accordance to licence. (Non endorsable) Licence expired but shown substantive and still allowed to drive

Speed checks conducted on CLIFF ROAD - 2x TOR's issued for excessive speed (40 and above) and several motorists warned for more minor infringements.

1x Stolen vehicle recovered (BMW 335 MX17WJE) - Activated ANPR cameras entering area. Sighted leaving West Yorkshire and caused to stop at J37. Driver detained but found to be an innocent purchaser. Vehicle seized.

No reports of ASB/Vehicle issues whilst in the area.

Checks conducted around KINGFISHER CHIP SHOP but no obstructions seen.
